Signed off road along track up hill to the camp site, 2 km to the west of the H333.

The cave has a large entrance, 10m high and 20m wide, and descends to a level area and shrine. A small hole beside the steps down may lead to a small entrance that is seen beside the steps up to the entrance.

The limestone dips steeply to the south-west.

The cave was explored and surveyed by the SMCC in January 2010.

Ban Ta Pern Kee, Wang Yaw, Phu Toei National Park

This cave is located near Ban Ta Pern Kee. A four wheel drive car is recommended for traveling to this cave and it is 200 m from Tham Ta Pern Thong.

Tham Ta Pern Ngern is a well decorated, medium sized limestone cave. The cave has a large chamber and is a through trip.

Tham Ta Pern Phet **SP0019**
Ban Ta Pern Kee, Wang Yaw, Phu Toei National Park

This cave is located near Ban Ta Pern Kee. A four wheel drive car is recommended for travelling to this cave.

This beautiful middle-size limestone cave has an entrance which is a 1 m wide crevice. After 5-6 m walking the cave opens out and it is possible to walk through to an exit on the other side of the cave.

Tham Ta Pern Thong **SP0018**
Ban Ta Pern Kee, Wang Yaw, Phu Toei National Park

This cave is located near Ban Ta Pern Kee. A four wheel drive car is recommended for travelling to this cave.

Inside the main chamber of the cave there is a Buddha image built by the Karen tribe which is worshiped by villagers. Connected to the chamber is another chamber accessed by a small passage.

Length: 149 m VR: 22 m

The cave is in the compound of Wat Wang Khan, 14 km north of Dan Chang along the H333, and one kilometre from the entrance of Phu Toei National Park.

Concrete stairs of 61 steps allow visitors to access the cave entrance easily. Steps inside the entrance descend to a chamber with two larger, high level entrances. This chamber houses a Buddha image in the Pa Lelai posture. A short 40 m long passage beyond the large Buddha leads to a skylight entrance.

Tham Weruwan is the type and only known locality for the snail *Kryobylos veruwan* Panha & Burch, 2004,

The thinly bedded limestone dips steeply to the west.

The cave was explored and surveyed by the SMCC in January 2010.
